#### **Notes:**

- Parents may opt out of Health Screenings and PSP Varnish by signing a form.
- A letter is given to parents along with registration paperwork to say yes/no to PSP varnish. A letter is sent home regarding Health Screenings - the letter includes the option to opt out.
- Parents are notified of negative dental issues by letter, after initial varnish. SFCC dental students come to SSR-7 to assess students' teeth. A form is sent to parents with any dental concerns.
- Parents are notified by letter if students fail a health screening 2 times (If a student fails vision, they will be rescreened in 2 weeks. If they fail vision again, a referral letter is sent to the parents). Parents are not notified of positive results, all screenings results are entered into Infinite Campus, parents may see results on Infinite Campus program.
- Re-screens are done on any student that fails hearing/vision 2 weeks after initial failure.
